IMPORTANT NOTES

1. The applicant must take due care while filling up Online Application Form that the information provided by the applicant are correct and are correctly filled in the form. The information provided by the applicant in their form shall not be changed or altered in any case and the University will not entertain any such request under any circumstances. The University shall not be liable for any mistake made by the applicant.
2. In case, the number of registered candidates at any of the examination centres is less than 100 (One Hundred), all such registered candidates will be allotted to the nearest examination centre.
3. There is no provision of revaluation/scrutiny of answer sheets.
4. In case of any discrepancy in the Hindi version, the English version of the brochure will be treated as final.
5. Only such RTI applications shall be entertained which are received within 60 days from the declaration of result.
6. Each candidate is required to mention their Sub-Category along with their Overall Category i.e., UR, SC, ST, OBC and EWS.
7. To give benefit to the students, who have passed the eligibility examination in the current year (2026-27) a deduction of 5% marks will be made for every gap year from the obtained PGAT marks. The maximum deduction will be 15%.
8. Every candidate will have to declare about any disciplinary action/police action against his/her.
9. Every candidate can view his/her Answer Sheet within **One Month** of declaration of Results by paying a token amount of Rs. 200/- at Pravesh Bhawan.
10. Entrance test centres:
ONLINE & OFFLINE (both): Prayagraj, Lucknow, Kanpur, Gorakhpur, Varanasi, Bareilly in Uttar Pradesh and New Delhi.
ONLINE only: Bhopal, Kolkata, Patna and Thiruvanthpuram.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

The minimum qualification for admission to the Master of Business Administration programme shall be graduation from a recognized Institution (Degree Course of at least three years duration with separate annual/semester examination system) from any stream. Students appearing in the final year examination of the undergraduate class are also permitted to apply, subject to the condition that they furnish their final graduation pass result not later than the date of admission.

Note: In case candidate has completed more than one undergraduate degree course, the first degree will be considered as qualifying examination.

Session Gap Deduction:

To give the benefit to students who have passed the eligibility examination in the current year (2025-26), a deduction of 5% marks would be made for every gap year from the obtained marks. The maximum deduction would be 15%.

2. SANCTIONED SEATS

Total 58 seats in MONIRBA and 58 seats in Govind Vallabh Pant Social Science Institute (GBPSSI) are available.

3. RESERVATION AND SPECIAL CONSIDERATION / QUOTA:

A. In accordance with provision of Section 9 of the University of Allahabad Act, 2005 (Act No. 26 of 2005) seats shall be reserved for Scheduled Caste (SC), Scheduled Tribe (ST), Other Backward Classes (OBC) and Economically Weaker Section (EWS) category candidates in all subjects / course for which the Admission Test has to be held, as given here under:

- (i) 15% of the total seats in each subject / course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Caste (SC) category;
- (ii) 7.5% of the total seats in each subject / course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Scheduled Tribe (ST) category; and
- (iii) 27% of the total seats in each subject / course shall be reserved for candidates belonging to Other Backward Caste (OBC) category.
- (iv) In case the seats reserved for Scheduled Tribe (ST) category candidates remain vacant on account of non-availability of candidates the same shall be filled by the candidates of Scheduled Caste (SC) and vice-versa.
- (v) 10% of the total seats shall be reserved for candidate belonging to EWS category.

Note: These rules are indicative and UGC Regulation on Reservation and directives of Ministry of Education as on the date of declaration of Results shall be followed.

B. Kashmiri Migrants:

Weightage as per Government of India guidelines shall be given to Kashmiri Migrants. In order to avail this weightage, the candidates shall have to present a certificate to this effect from an officer of the Ministry of Education not below the rank of Joint Secretary or equivalent.

C. Foreign Nationals/NRI:

Foreign Nationals shall be required to apply through International Students Advisor in accordance with the procedure laid down by the University of Allahabad. The candidate in this case shall not be required to appear in the Admission Test / Entrance Test, but shall be considered for admission on the recommendation of a committee constituted for the purpose, which shall examine the academic credentials and certificates of the candidate before making any recommendation.

D. Person with Disability (Divyang):

- (i) As per section 32(1) of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, all Government institutions of higher education and other higher education institutions receiving aid from the Government shall reserve not less than **five (05) per cent** seats for person with benchmark disabilities. Therefore, 5% of total seats for these courses will be available for person with disability who can pursue this course without any difficulty.
- (ii) A candidate who has a certified disability of not less than 40% in any limb or in orthopaedic structure which, in the opinion of the Medical Board (constituted by the University of Allahabad), amounts to an overall physical handicap of not more than 70% or is a certified Visually impaired or a Hearing impaired, may be admitted to the concerned course / subject, irrespective of his position in the order of merit of the total aggregate score, on the recommendation of the Medical Board.
- (iii) Seats under this quota shall be filled in order of preference given below. One percent each shall be reserved for person with benchmark disability under clause (a), (b), (c), (d) and (e) namely.
 - a. Blindness and low vision.
 - b. Deaf and hard of hearing.
 - c. Locomotor disability including cerebral palsy, leprosy cured, dwarfism, acid attack victims and muscular dystrophy.
 - d. Autism, intellectual disability, specific learning disability and mental illness.
 - e. Multiple disabilities amongst person from clauses (a) to (d).
- (iv) The privilege shall not be given except claimed by the candidate at the time of application. At the time of admission, the candidate shall be required to produce a certificate issued by the Chief Medical Officer of the appropriate District or by the Viklang Kendra, Prayagraj, which testifies to his disability and bears an attested photograph indicating their disability clearly.
- (v) Admission under PwD quota will be strictly on the basis of merit list provided by the DSW/ Medical Board of the University of Allahabad.
- (vi) **All candidates entitled to be admitted under the above quota to a course shall be adjusted against their respective social category.**

Note: For admission under this category, it is mandatory for candidate claiming such quota to appear before the Medical Board duly constituted by the Dean, Students Welfare (DSW).

E. Teacher/Employee Spouse Quota:

- i. After the completion of admission on the sanctioned seats in each course of study, the wife/husband, sons and daughters of regularly appointed serving and retired teachers / employee of the University, the University Institutes, the constituents Colleges and constituents Institutes which we shall call unit hereafter, who produce relevant certificate duly signed by the Registrar in case of University, the Director in case of University Institutes, the Principal in the case of constituent Colleges (units) and the Director in case of constituent Institutes shall be admitted, on the basis of their relative scores against 5% supernumerary seats (with a minimum of one seat) in each course of study, only in the unit in which such Teachers/Employees are serving or from where they have superannuated,

Provided that in case seats remain vacant in a course in the unit, these will be filled by the wards of the employees of other units,

- ii. It is clarified that the unit mentioned in clause (i) means the university/constituent colleges of the university.
- iii. Teacher/Employee Ward benefit will be granted only when the candidate has made such a claim in the Application Form and presents the required documents and certificates at the time of admission. The order of merit for admission shall be determined on the basis of computed marks of the candidate.

FOREIGN STUDENTS

Admission of foreign nationals shall be made strictly as per recommendations of the Foreign Students Advisor of the University as supernumerary seats. Foreign students recommended from time to time by the Government of India shall be exempted from Admission Test.

Note: No weightage for NCC/NSS shall be given for Admission in B.Ed., M.Ed., MBA & MBA(RD) courses. Sports quota shall not be available under these courses.

REQUIREMENT TO APPEAR FOR ADMISSION TEST

All applicants, except the foreign national applicants applying through the prescribed channel shall have to appear in the PGAT.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The admission to the MBA course shall be based on Admission Test comprising of **PGAT and Oral Tests (Group Discussion & Personal Interview)**. All tests shall be conducted only in English medium.

FEE STRUCTURE

For securing admission to MBA programme in UoA, the shortlisted candidate shall be required to pay the following fee **in addition to the University fee**. The University fee shall be payable online during counselling. The Professional course fee and Young Executive Club (YEC) membership fee shall be paid via demand draft.

TEST (300 MARKS):

The PGAT tests shall judge applicants for proficiency in written communication, intelligence, propensity to observe facts and use them, propensity to grasp and use quantitative and scientific tools, general awareness, logical thinking, reasoning power, aptitude for management learning and practice, and maturity in terms of personality.

Note: - Admission Test shall be held through Online Mode only at the centre allotted by the University on the Admit Card.

Number of candidates called for group discussion (GD) & personal interview (PI):

The number of candidates to be called for GD and PI Test shall be three times the number of Seats in the MONIRBA for MBA and GBPSSI for MBA-RD.

Group Discussion (50 Marks)

Group leadership test shall be done by grouping the applicants in viable groups and conducting discussion on chosen themes to test the applicant's leadership ability, group behaviour, and adjustment with group dynamics.

Personal Interview (50 Marks)

Personal Interview will be held for each candidate separately to test overall suitability of a candidate for doing M.B.A.

FINAL LIST OF SELECTED CANDIDATES:

The final list of selected candidates shall be drawn on the basis of the overall performance of the candidates in the PGAT, GD & PI Tests. Every candidate has to appear in PGAT and GD & PI Tests. Thus, a candidate, who is, for whatsoever reason, does not present himself in any of the above Test(s) shall not be considered for final admission. Result shall be declared on the official website of University of Allahabad and displayed on the notice board of MONIRBA and GBPSSI.

If the score of two or more candidates is identical in overall Admission Test, the admission shall be granted on the following basis:

- Score of PGAT.
- Percentage of Marks scored in Graduate Examination, in case of score in PGAT is also identical,
- By drawing a lottery. If the marks in Graduate Examination are same.

A student after being declared successful must deposit their fees within stipulated time. If student do not collect their Intimation Card and deposit the fee by the required date, they will not be admitted for admission and the candidate next in merit will be given admission.

TEST CENTRES

The PGAT shall be held at the centers mentioned on the front page of this brochure. The candidate shall have the option to appear from any one of the specified centers. In case the number of applicants opting for a centre is less than 100, the University shall have the right to cancel that centre and direct the candidates to appear in any nearest centre registered by them in their application forms or as decided by the University. The Group Discussion/Personal Interview for the short-listed candidates shall be conducted only at Prayagraj. The Candidates shall have to make their own arrangements for travel and stay for appearing in the PGAT and oral tests and shall not be entitled to any TA/DA.

How to Apply Online:

- i. The address of the website is <https://aupravesh2026.cbtextam.in/> or click on the PG Admission-2026 link of www.allduniv.ac.in.
- ii. After opening the website, the name of the Entrance Examination, its online starting date for filling up the form, its date of closing will be displayed. The candidate has to opt the class in which he/she wishes to appear in the Entrance Examination.
- iii. Upon opening the website, buttons will be displayed for downloading the Brochure, and opening the Online Application Form, for Printing Application form and for printing Admit Card. The candidates are advised to read the instructions and click the button to agree and accept the conditions/instructions. Option for printing Admit Card shall be available only from the date given in the schedule for Admission Test.

- iv. The candidate is advised to read the downloaded Brochure before filling up the Application Form. After reading the Brochure carefully the candidate is advised to click the "Apply Online" button. Upon clicking the "Apply Online" button the application form will be displayed on the screen. The candidate is required to fill up the form correctly and as per instructions mentioned in the Brochure. The fields/columns marked with red asterisk are mandatory to be filled.
- v. The scanned copy of photograph and signature as per requirement shall be uploaded in the Application form which is mandatory.
- vi. After filling up the Application Form the candidate can view his filled-up application form with the use of preview application form button.
- vii. After ensuring that all the entries have been filled up by the candidate correctly, the candidate can submit the form online by entering the correct image code displayed on the screen.

Online Payment:

- a. **The details of payment mode will be displayed then click PAY ONLINE.**
 - b. **On clicking PAY ONLINE button the applicant will be connected to gateway for payment.**
 - c. **Then select the available payment option.**
 - d. **Then fill the details as required and then submit the application form & get a printout of application form.**
- viii. The information provided and the data supplied by the applicant through Registration Form shall be preserved in the University for a period of only six months from the date of the declaration of the result of Entrance/Admission Test. The records will be disposed of after the said period and no enquiry shall be entertained in this regard by the University after the expiry of the said period. The University shall use this data in various staze during the admission process. hence, in no case shall any change be allowed at a later stage. Therefore, all the information must be furnished correctly, completely and clearly by the applicant himself/herself as per the instructions given in the brochure/website.
 - ix. The Evaluated OMR Answer Sheets/Online Answer Booklets will be preserved only for a period of six months after the declaration of results of Entrance/Admission Test. The records will be disposed-off after the said period and no enquiry shall be entertained in this regard by the University after the expiry of the said period.

The University may cancel the candidature of such applicants who furnish incomplete, wrong or deliberate misinformation; or conceal the facts in Online Registration Form.

Admit Card: Admit Card for all the valid applications received by the University will be processed and enabled on the website. The Candidates can download their admit card from the website after entering their Application ID and Date of Birth. All Admit Cards will be uploaded for all the valid applications. University will not send any admit card by post or distribute them from the counters.
